# Kenya Mission Trips

Habitat mission trips are *building trips*.

While in Kenya, we will work alongside local masons and neighbors to build new houses or improve existing shelter.



## Common tasks

- Foundation excavation
- Wall Construction
- Roofing
- Plastering
- Floor Slab Construction
- Repair existing homes/infrastructure

Lighter tasks, including painting, are available for those unable to do heavier work.



## The Kenya Experience

On the worksite, you will learn about the technology that Habitat for Humanity Kenya has identified that makes their houses low-cost, energy efficient and sturdy for the long haul.



Participants should be at least 18 years of age (16, if accompanied by a parent or guardian), have a valid passport, and be physically capable to do the work. It is expected that participants support the mission of Habitat for Humanity— Seeking to put God’s work into action, Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities and hope.



During the week, you will build and stay in a secure village and experience the culture and beauty of rural Kenya. You will be connected with a partner family, an authentic slice of Kenya, and get a glimpse of how Habitat breaks the poverty cycle for families.

At the conclusion of the work with Habitat Kenya, there will be an opportunity arranged to stay at a hotel in the city to experience the culture of Kenya.
